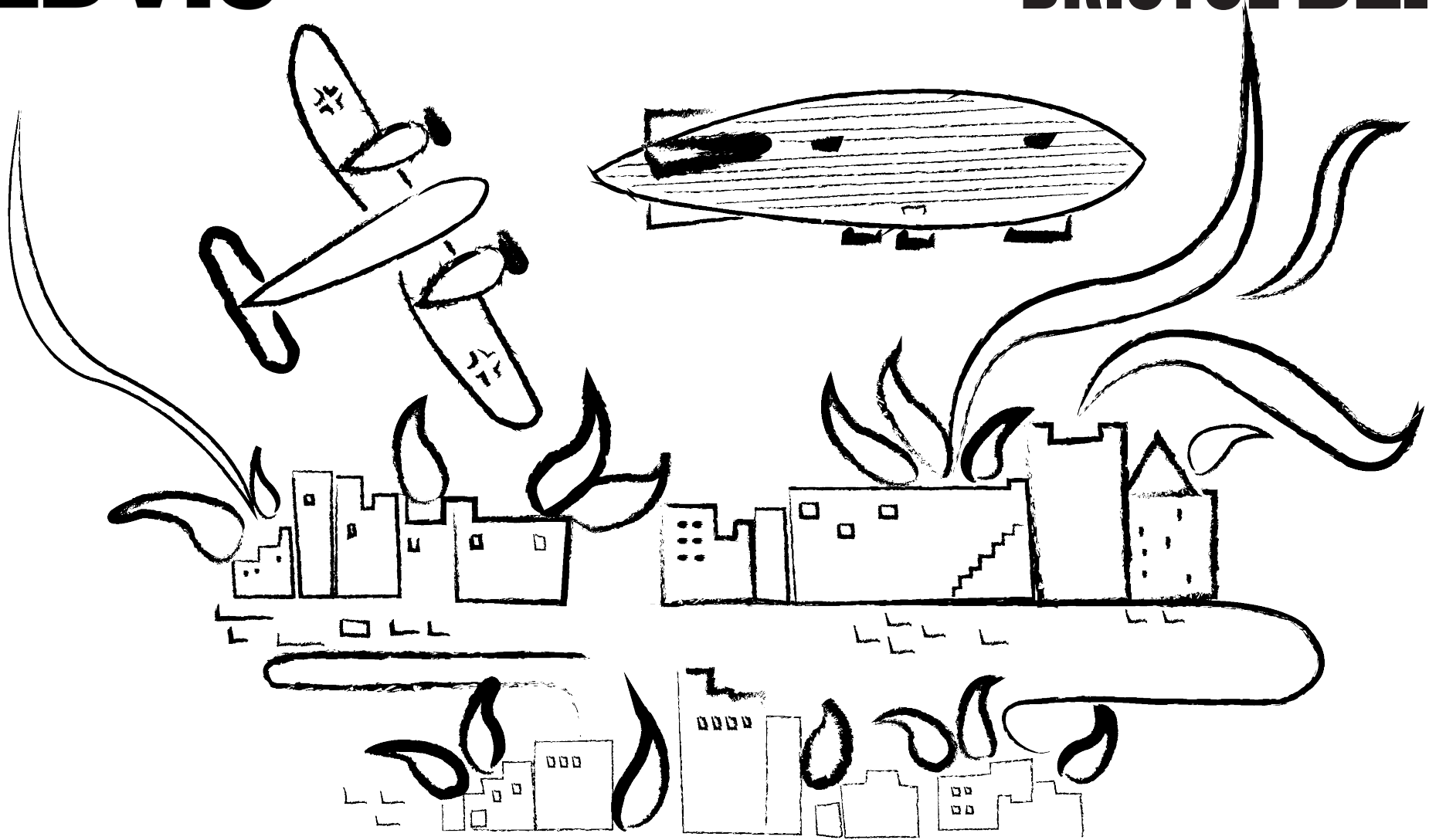


BRISTOL OLD VIC

COLOUR IN KING STREET: BRISTOL BLITZ



Between the winter of 1940 and early 1941 many buildings on King Street were damaged or destroyed in the bombing of the city during the Blitz. Merchants' Hall, a section of the Merchants' Almshouses, and part of the row of buildings that are now called the Llandogor Trow were all hit. Miraculously, the theatre survived untouched by the violence.
