If you get to a really tense or exciting moment, or really into what you are watching, the last thing you want is to be distracted by a phone light, or sound. If you use it in the auditorium, the ushers have the right to confiscate it for the duration of the show.
- Coming to the theatre and watching a show is a shared experience. You share it with your friends, the actors, the staff and all of the other audience members. How you conduct yourself will have a direct impact on those around you, so please do be respectful and mindful of others, so you all have a great experience.
- Snacks and drinks are allowed in the theatre, you can even enjoy an ice cream at the interval. When eating or drinking in your seat, please be careful not to rustle any wrappers loudly, spill anything, or go for a big handful of crisps in a really quiet moment of the show.
- Talk about your visit. We hope you have a great time here, and we'd love you to tell others about your trip to Bristol Old Vic. Take a selfie in the foyer (no photos in the theatre please) or post a story about how you found the show. Theatre is all about stories, and we want you to think about and share those stories in your classroom and with friends.
