YOUNG COMPANY

Our long-running youth theatre programme with weekly sessions for everyone aged 3–25.



YOUNG COMPANY GLOBAL MAJORITY

A new weekly group for young people aged 13+ from the Global Majority.



YOUNG COMPANY CITY

Weekly drama sessions from Jan–July in various locations across the city, working towards a devised performance at Bristol Old Vic. Groups span from 8–18.



YOUNG SIX SIX

A year-round weekly drama group for young people aged 13–17 who struggle to engage with the education system, or who are lacking in confidence. Young SixSix offers pastoral support for life skills, as well as industry experience.



WORK EXPERIENCE

Week-long work experience for Year 10 in June (ages 14–15) and Year 12 in July (ages 16–17) students who want to learn more about the theatre sector.



TECHNICAL YOUTH THEATRE

Weekly sessions from Jan–Jul for young people aged 15–19 interested in backstage roles.



REP' & ERASURE

For young people aged 16–21 who are interested in history, social activism and digital arts. Sessions run Apr–Jul.



DRAMA FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

For anyone aged 16+ who wants to improve their English through play and performance.
